Prizes in each section: 1st £150, 2nd £100, 3rd £50 plus a grading prize of £30

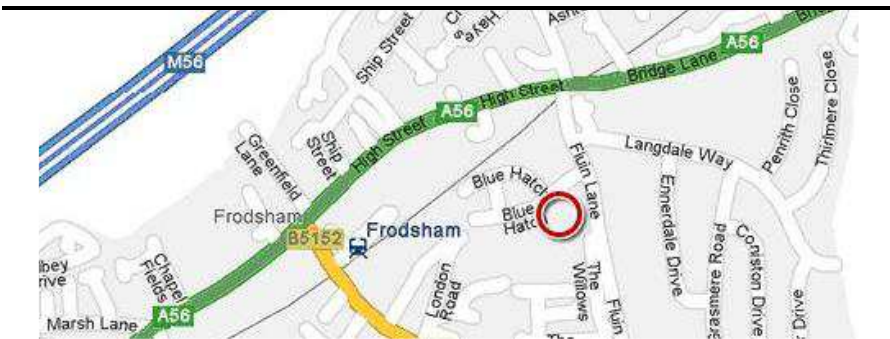

ENTRY FEES: Standard fee, all sections £20

Reductions of

- £3.00 for any player aged under 18 or Over 65 on 1st September 2011. Your date of birth must be supplied if you wish to claim either of these.
- £3.00 for members of the English Chess Federation, Welsh Chess Union or Scottish Chess Association. Your membership number must be supplied if you wish to claim this.
- £8 for any player playing in the Go tournament on Saturday.

There will be a £3 surcharge for entries received after Wednesday 8th February.

GRADING: The August 2011 Grading List will be used (*not* the new list to be published in January, except in those cases were a player has a grade in the new list but not in the August list).

Ungraded players must provide information to assist the organisers in allocating them to the appropriate section. Any previous grade must be declared. A player without a current published grade in a grading list recognised by the organisers will not be eligible to win more than £50. All results will be submitted to the ECF for grading. It is a condition of entry that players agree to their grading information being published on the ECF website.

TEAM COMPETITION: There will be a team competition for teams of four who are bone fide members of a club, with the best three scores to count.

REFRESHMENTS: A selection of drinks and light refreshments will be available during playing hours.

ACCOMMODATION: If you require an accommodation list please supply an email address (email requests to patrick.ridley@ntlworld.com) or enclose a stamped, addressed, envelope with your entry form.

CHESHIRE GO TOURNAMENT: This will be held at the same venue on Saturday 11th February. If you wish to play in both tournaments you may take 2 half-point byes in the chess on the Saturday and have an £8 reduction in your entry fee.
